

Safety Partnership Program Terms and Conditions

1. Partnership Application

- a. The partnership commences from the date of application, receipt of payment, and acceptance of the terms and conditions as outlined on the Safety Australia Group (SAG) website.
- b. By agreeing to SAG's terms and conditions, you grant SAG permission to publish your logo and website URL on the SAG website unless you specifically request otherwise.
- c. Partners must join a package that reflects the size of their business/organisation as per the size guide detailed on the partnership page of the SAG website.
- d. SAG reserves the right to refuse any application at their discretion.
- e. SAG may refuse a partnership application if they determine the package is not appropriate for the size of the business or organisation.

2. Partnership Fees

a. The partnership program fee is payable in full at the time of joining.

3. Cancellation of Partnership

- a. Partnership fees are non-refundable unless SAG deems a refund appropriate or if SAG refuses a partnership application.
- b. Partnership entitlements, including complimentary tickets, become invalid if a partnership agreement is cancelled.

4. Partnership Entitlements

- a. Complimentary tickets are valid for 12 months from the joining date.
- b. Partnership discounts may vary according to the entitlements of the chosen package.
- c. Partners must provide a minimum of 24-48 hours' notice for WHS Support call bookings. Appointments are subject to the availability of consultants.
- d. Support calls are logged in 15-minute blocks, up to the maximum hours. Additional support calls and/or onsite WHS support are available at SAG's standard market safety consultant rates per hour.
- e. WHS Support calls provide partners with information and general guidance only and are not considered legal advice or comprehensive WHS advice. Partners are responsible for conducting their own enquiries.

5. Privacy

- a. SAG is bound by privacy legislation and the National Privacy Principles.

6. Safety Newsletter

- a. New partners will be automatically subscribed to Safety Australia Group's quarterly electronic Safety newsletter.
